TD PLACE STADIUM

Tell my parents when I need to use the washroom.


Listen to the TD Place staff at all times.

FINDING MY SEAT

WARM UP

Right before the game starts, everyone will sing Oh Canada! I will stand up with everyone and take my hat off. I can sing if I want to, but if I don't want to I will just listen to everyone else sing the song.

CHEERING
